I've been driving the Dakota steadily all Fall, Winter and ?Spring? since its road-inauguration last September. The mileage odometer now reads 94080 which means i've driven it 1577 miles since Sept. 2017. i really like the truck. It's useful, light and nimble.




i love that it is a quad-cab with much more interior space than my S-10 had.




I've been using it for quite a bit of hauling... mostly for firewood for heating my home this Winter. And also sleds for FUN!




Forward projects include, but are not limited to.... Finding a permanent weather-proof place to mount the onboard charger. This quick kludge last Sept. has limited my driving some on wet days:



Creating a tilt-bed system. This was a quick kludge to get access to the rear battery box for NDEW:



And last but not least, when (IF?) the weather warms up, install the BMS system! Driving non-BMS-less during the Winter months has given me some concern because the pack voltage sags quite a bit and i'm concerned that some cells are dropping below their recommended operating voltage (2.5v). The BMS will give me data towards this concern and also protect the cells from overcharging on the top end. This will be the most complicated part of the Dakota project for sure. Please stay tuned for more.


