Monday night I had a good experience in Naperville working with the government people to learn how they run their own grid. Bruce, Maureen, and Greg were all there too and it was definitely a learning experience for everyone there. One of the outcomes of that is that we are going to be helping the residents of Naperville learn about EV's! **This involves the Naperville power company directing people to our group to learn everything about EV's**. One of immediate tasks is to create a nice page of educational material to provide to the Naperville power company to distribute with their EV education package. I am excited to work with a team of people to put this together and start developing an EV training program for residents.

Saving Gas in your PHEV, Outlander PHEV edition

Last month I found that there are ways to keep the Volt engine from running in the winter. This month I tried our Outlander PHEV and I found that if you leave the heat off the engine won't run. With that you can avoid burning gas around town 12 months of the year. You can run the heat if the outside air temperature gage says it is above 35 degrees and it will use the battery, just turn the heat off before the gage cools to 35 and the

engine won't run.

Bad news, the FVEAA sign has fallen

After barely a season in my care the FVEAA sign fell over while I was working on replacing the "loudly buzzing" contactor in my fourth charging station and several pieces of the tube broke off. While it might be repairable I am leaning towards building a sign that at least as bright, but can roll or fold up for much easier transport. This sign would also be less vulnerable to breakage due to President's working on EVSE nearby. I have quite a few ideas and am happy to fund the project as I broke the old guy, so look forward to some work sessions in the warmer months this year. Conceptually I was thinking we might make it compatible with outdoor usage for our EVents, but more work to be done around those decisions.


Encouraging Our Membership To Grow in 2019 and Some History
