


Encouraging Our Membership To Grow in 2019 and Some History

Meeting Minutes January 18, 2018 -

- WELCOME Jeffrey Miller opened the meeting at 7:05
- Introductions lasted 40 minutes
- Bruce with assistance from Jeff and the team, provided an overview of a meeting on Monday of this
 week with the Mayor of Naperville, Steve Chirico, Mark Curran head of the Naperville Public Utility. Jeff
 Miller, Greg Hubert, Maureen Stillman of the FVEAA were in attendance. He also showed some slides
 of what projected EV sales were back in 2012 along with slides of Transformer overload situations.
- The Meeting set up by Jodi Trendler of the Resiliency Institute was meant to promote the use of electric vehicles in Naperville and voice dissatisfaction with high costs (dis-incentives) that EV owners face when looking to install a home EVSE in Naperville. Sometimes the local transformer needs to be upgraded and we are forced to pay a high variable fee to upgrade it... as opposed to Naperville coming up with a low or no cost way to fund the transformer upgrades, which could come from existing maintenance budgets.

ISSUE: Naperville charges unfair fees for Local Transformer when installing Home EVSE

- Residents Pay a fee variable fee under discussion from \$300 to \$500 but
- The city mentioned a smaller fee \$300 500 range
- o Greg Hubert received a notice that \$7k would be split 5 ways (\$1400) which is much higher

and he argued it is fundamentally unfair. Everyone should pay the same fee.

- We are going to request *no fee or a small consistent fee* for everyone in Naperville
- Naperville should pick up the rest of cost from their substantial Maintenance Budgets

City replacing the broken charging stations downtown Naperville

- Recommended they put a note on the EVSE downtown that they are not operating!
- We need smart EVSE managed by the City
- City should take advantage of TESLA program for charging stations

COAL Powered IMEA

 Naperville signed a contract through 2035 for coal powered electricity with the IMEA (Illinois

Municipal Electric Agency) a consortium of 32 Illinois cities.

- Bulk of power from Prairie State Energy Campus (Coal plant) southeast of St. Louis
- The city of Naperville did not consume as much power as it expected the last year or so.

5% - 10% Wind Next year 2020

 City hoping to use more renewables, but it didn't sound like they had a commitment to do so.

Naperville Utility - EV Education opportunity for FVEAA

- Naperville Utility may be directing people to FVEAA for assistance with questions on Electric Vehicles
- Jeff leading a team (us!) to create educational material to provide to the Naperville
 Utility to distribute with their EV education package.
- o Bruce showed a basic home Checklist and we can leverage our FVEAA brochure
 - Sustainability Task Force to work w Mark Curran (Retiring in April) and Lucy

Smart Grid to tie to Web site in 3QTR.

- O There were problems with the Smart grid web software purchased several years ago
- the Utility has been writing their own software.
- O It has also been delayed and may be complete and online by 3rd Qtr
