

John Emde was a leader of the EV movement. We all stand on his shoulders, and his actions have influenced not just us, but the entire EV movement that is launching on our little blue planet. John is one of the few that caused the Electric Car market to exist. He persistently supported EV's in a way that only a few people in the world have. I am sad to see him go, but I am glad he got to see the beginning of the EV revolution. Unlike the false start in the 90's, John got to see the EV market start running on it's own, not just with compliance cars, but with cars sold in all the states and many countries of the world. He also got to see high end AC drive systems come to conversions providing efficiency on par with the best OEM motors in the business. He got to see battery technology that made it possible to shrink an electric dragster down from the size of Aggravated Battery to a Honda Insight. He got to see controllers move from extremely crude contactor controllers to the water cooled works of art we have today. Beyond all that, he had a big hand in making those changes happening! The world will move on without him, but because of him, it is truly a better place.

Clearly the 1000 per year tax on EV's was excessive. We ended up with the new standard plate fee + 100 road tax fee. I am expecting a total renewal of \$251 at the end of the year for my EL plated car as it goes into force on January 1st. Hopefully the state makes the transition smooth since the change in fees start on the same day as all the EL plated cars need to renew. My currently Non-EL plated car will not be changed over to EL plates until it's renewal in late 2020. I am not happy that they are penalizing EV's and I have some thoughts on this topic that I will talk about in the future.

The video embedded in this article is one of the clearest pieces of information I have ever seen on the degradation of batteries. I watched it a couple of times and it is well worth your time. My biggest takeaway is that charging a cold battery is absolutely terrible for it. Last winter I made the mistake of driving and then fast charging after the car sat for a few hours. It was plugged into a 110 outlet but it took it about 15 minutes before it could start charging at a decent pace at the local fast charger. In the future I will try VERY hard to charge my care when warm, and have a mostly full pack to discharge before needing to charge again. Hot batteries are a

Hot batteries are a concern for everyone, and plenty of damage can happen to a hot battery, but as batteries mature I see less and less issues with batteries being excessively hot. For example the Model 3 now preheats it's battery on the way to the Super Charger stations. I doubt my old Model S had to bother with adding heat to the battery as I approached the station, it always seemed to be plenty warm.







John in the "Aggravated Battery" Electric Drag racer


