I reviewed Jeff Balch's home for suitability for adding car charging, and much to my surprise he has 6 open slots in his 20 slot panel along with sufficient capacity to support a single EV. However it works out I look forward to helping him in the future.

I also helped John Balk by educating him on the basics of how to do electrical work, and permit applications. He has taken that knowledge and applied for a permit in Geneva to do his own work. I have checked his paperwork and will help him once he gets approval to do the work.

Marc S, who presented a few months back, now has a Chrysler Pacific PHEV, and a 100 amp subpanel is his garage which we will be installing a pair of OpenEVSE stations to support his current and future EV's. I guided him through that process and helped him avoid a couple of pitfalls already, and we haven't even built anything yet.




Encouraging Our Membership To Grow and Some History
