An automated balancing system for RV's to regulate charging and other hotel loads. Uses OpenEVSE and other off the shelf parts. Should be trivial to adapt to a home if anyone has OpenEVSE and a limited service. There are houses with only 60 amps where something like this could be very useful, but even some 100amp service homes could use this. The only real limitation is that it only updates every 30 seconds so you need to leave some margin for things to start up. It does "fail safe" as in if it doesn't hear from the controller it stops charging. This setup only charges one car.


